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Highlights

- Good model for involvement of local Postgraduate Trust in teaching
- Formal Significant Event Analysis of problems that arise
- Running the ST1 GP induction twice on the same day (am and pm) enabled 100% attendance
- All but one TPD is a trainer; this means that there is TPD representation in each Trainer Group

Areas that must be changed in the next year

- None

Recommendations

- Disseminate some of the excellent initiatives by publication
- Keep an eye on the standard of the hospital posts; end-of-post survey results suggest that, while the good posts are getting better, some posts are getting more negative feedback this year
