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### Highlights

- Very experienced and competent teachers
- Structure of the HDR carefully thought out, producing excellent results
- Good group-led presentations
- High use of GPs-with-a-special-interest
- Coordinated with PG Trust teaching
- Effective teamwork, good internal support and interaction with APD
- Galvanised by unexpectedly high level of CSA failures

### Areas that must be changed in the next year

- None

### Recommendations

- Share ideas as much as possible (TPD days, publications)
- Inevitably, because of other teaching like patch tutorials and PG Trust meetings, formal ST3 half-day teaching in the postgraduate centre is less frequent; the team needs to “mind the gap” and ensure that ST3s are adequately supported
