## **Post-return meeting**

## The meeting

- After the period of enhanced supervision
- Held by new Educational Supervisor
- Set aside 30-60 minutes, in a relaxed but confidential space (either virtual or face-to-face)
- Review the trainee's progress since returning
- Once satisfied with progress, the trainee can be signed off to resume usual clinical duties
- Signpost to available resources (<a href="https://www.severndeanery.nhs.uk/about-us/supportt-2/">https://www.severndeanery.nhs.uk/about-us/supportt-2/</a>)

## **Discussion points**

- Clinical skills and knowledge
- Trainee's confidence
- Review e-portfolio including any Work-place Based Assessments completed
- Does period of enhanced supervision need extending? Notify the SuppoRTT champion and TPD if this is required
- Any coaching or mentoring required? Refer to PSW
- Signpost to return to training courses, activities and resources

## The SuppoRTT plan

- Complete the form at the end of the meeting after the discussion
- Summarise important discussion points being mindful of the documentation of sensitive issues
